### **\*RELIGIOUS EDUCATION CLASSES**

Most Holy Trinity offers Religious Education classes for children 4 years old through adult. Religious Education classes (K-Adult) are held Sunday mornings on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of Thayer Hall at 0915. The 4 year old pre-k children meet Sunday mornings in the Cloister room of the Chapel at 0900. Children preparing for the sacraments of Reconciliation, Eucharist and Confirmation attend grade level classes on Sunday morning and then again during the week for their sacrament preparation. Children must attend both classes. Sacramental preparation classes will begin the end of September.
