

APL MAJOR (APL0)

Cadets choose Philosophy or Literature track. Majors take 10 courses: EP333 and EP433; a track-based methodology course (EP344 or EP359); at least four electives within the track; one art history course; a 3rd (300-level) foreign-language course, and one other literature or philosophy elective.
