


WEST POINT, NEW YORK, USMA NATURAL AND CULTURAL RESOURCES



TRAINING AND THE ENVIRONMENT
Soldier's Field Guide

FIRE PREVENTION

- Obey restrictions of the Fire Danger Rating.
- Take precautions to prevent forest and range fires.
- Use no pyrotechnics without approval from chain of command.
- Immediately report and attempt to extinguish fires should they start (USMA Fire Dept. 938-3001).

TRAINING ACTIVITIES

- Do not cut live trees for camouflage. Use camouflage netting for concealment.
- Do not cut, damage, or otherwise remove live trees, shrubs or seedlings.
- Do not dump ANY materials or objects into streams or interfere with the normal water flow of streams.
- Coordinate with Range Control before digging foxholes or any other emplacements.
- Police your area and properly dispose of refuse. Do not burn or bury garbage, refuse, or rubbish.
- Do not leave training ordnance or ammo wire in woodlands after training.
- Do not create unnecessary noise or dust or use smoke near occupied dwellings or installation boundaries.
- Remove all concertina/barbed wire at conclusion of training.
- Accomplish required training with a consciousness for environmental protection and stewardship.

PROTECTED AREAS

- Do not disturb wildlife or their habitats.
- Do not disturb tree shelters or deer enclosures in the woodlands.
- Do not harm snakes. The Timber Rattlesnake is a **Threatened** species (Report sightings to x3857).
- Take care when moving near ponds, marshes, streams and other wet, low-lying areas.
- Stay out of restricted access areas.
- Do not disturb archaeological, historical or cultural resources. These include building foundations, cellar holes, stone fences, mine excavations and wells and cisterns.

VEHICLE MOVEMENT

- Drive only on range roads and limit off road use of vehicles.
- Obey posted speed and capacity limits on roads and trails.
- Do not drive through wetlands or streams.
- Report maneuver damage to your chain of command or Range Control (938-3930/4317).

PETROLEUM, OIL AND LUBRICANTS

- Use and store lubricants only in maintenance areas.
- Use spill pans whenever POL is being handled, especially around streams, lakes and wetlands, to prevent the contamination of the soil or water with petroleum products.
- Clean up all POL contaminated soil. Contain and report all POL spills immediately to the Environmental Office (938-3224).
