### **Hemphill Practice Fields (Football / Lacrosse)**

#### **A. EMERGENCY PERSONNEL**

- Certified Athletic Trainer on-site for practices/games. Additional certified athletic trainer(s) available during normal business hours (Monday – Friday 0830-1800) in Building 1204E. Physicians available at Patterson Army Health Clinic 0730-1630) / EMS on-call.

#### **C. ROLES OF THE FIRST RESPONDER**

1. Immediate care of the injured or ill student-athlete
2. Activation of the Emergency Medical Services (EMS)
  - a. **911 call**
    - Give your name
    - Location / Address ([see below](#))
    - Telephone number you are calling from
    - Explain the exact problem / emergency
    - Approximate age of victim
    - Conscious: Yes / No?
    - Breathing: Yes / No?
    - Is there severe bleeding?
    - Do you need a lights and siren response?
    - Inform dispatcher of the escort meeting point ([see below](#))
  - b. Contact Athletic trainer once EMS has been contacted
3. Direction of EMS to scene
  - a. Open appropriate doors
  - b. Venue Directions:  
[Hemphill Field located between Abbey Ave. and Whitesell Ave](#)  
**Escort Meeting point:** [On Abbey Ave; outside building](#)
  - c. Designate individual to meet EMS at escort meeting point and direct to scene
  - d. Limit scene to first aid providers and move bystanders away from area
  - e. Victim to be transported to Riverview Medical Center Emergency Room

  - AED
  - Oxygen
