All applicants for this position should note the following information:

- The main duties associated with this position are performed on CC and BBb instruments. Please ensure that the vast majority of your recording is performed on one of these horns.
- DVDs and/or CDs are the only accepted recording mediums.
- **Do not** sacrifice audio quality to make a video recording.
- The winner of this position will be expected to depart for basic training on or about September 10, 2009.

All materials are due by June 29, 2009

Selected applicants will be invited to audition at West Point at government expense.
