

TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

A shuttle bus service will provide transportation to the main post areas from lot A (pick-up point) and the Buffalo Soldier Field (daily shuttle on Friday) parking area during the times shown. The buses will be marked for Plebe-Parent Weekend guests.

The shuttle bus service will travel in a circular route and will stop at the locations shown below every 30 minutes.

Handicapped parking - Guests are encouraged to use the shuttle bus service. The stops are closer than most available handicapped parking. Handicapped parking will be available in Clinton Lot and in the lot east of Trophy Point.
