#### ***1. Hosting visitors:***

- b. From 23 May to 10 June, CPT(P) Chen is leading his group of 12 cadets to Taiwan on the Chinese language section's first cultural and language immersion program this summer. They are spending time at the Taiwan Military Academy in Gaoxiong and FuJen University in Taipei.
- c. From 23 May to 10 June, the Arabic section is coordinating a cultural and language immersion program for 7 Cadets currently in Cairo, Egypt. The cadets will spend 4 days/week in intensive Arabic and Spoken Egyptian coursework at the Drayah Language Center and will participate in cultural immersion trips for the remaining 3 days/week.
- c. From 23 May to 10 June, the Spanish section is coordinating a cultural and language immersion program to Chile.
