PLEASE RINSE ALL ITEMS THAT CONTAINED FOOD.

BUNDLED ITEMS



NEWSPRINT MAY BE BUNDLED NO MORE THAN 12 INCHES HIGH WITH TWINE OR PLACED LOOSE IN THE “BLUE” RECYCLE BIN.



CORRUGATED CARDBOARD (PACKING BOXES) MUST BE BROKEN DOWN AND BUNDLED. FOR LARGE AMOUNTS, BREAK DOWN BOXES AND PLACE IN ONE OR TWO OF THE BOXES FOR COLLECTION. DO NOT PUT TRASH IN THESE BOXES.

DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS OF ANY KIND IN THE RECYCLE BINS. CO-MINGLE AND PAPER PRODUCTS SHOULD BE PLACED IN CANS LOOSE.

PLASTIC BAG RECYCLING BINS ARE LOCATED IN FRONT OF COMMISARY AND AT THE POST EXCHANGE.

SELF HELP HAS “BLUE” CONTAINERS FOR THE COLLECTION OF THE PAPER ITEMS AND THE “YELLOW” CONTAINER FOR CO-MINGLE ITEMS. IF YOU NEED ADDITIONAL CANS SELF HELP WILL ISSUE THEM TO YOU.

DO NOT RECYCLE

CONTAINER #1 Co-Mingle

- Pots, pans, utensils and other cookware
- Ceramic and china dinnerware
- Plastic buckets, planters, baskets and recycle bins
- Containers that held hazardous material (oil, antifreeze, pool and yard chemicals, spackle, oil-based paint, etc)
- Plastic bags (recycle at commissary, P.X. or recycle center)
- Styrofoam
- Light bulbs
- Metal or plastic hangers (recycle at laundry)
- Toys
- IV bags, medical waste and containers containing medical sharps

CONTAINER #2 Paper Products

NO

- Paper soiled with grease or food contamination that cannot be removed
- Wax coated paper
- Paper cups
- Tissues, toilet paper, paper towels, napkins
- Paper items with layers of plastic or foil (Gift Wrapping Paper)
- Paper used for animal training or bedding
- Cat litter
