Details are limited, but I want to advise you of the information I have at this time. Currently, there are no applications being sent out or accepted. Once we have everything confirmed with West Point, the application will be sent out and posted on our web site. As more information becomes available, it will also be posted on forums such as AR15.com and BrianEnos.com.

I ask that you limit your questions until we have everything finalized and details are published, but as you know I will reply in a timely fashion to all questions sent to this email address cwtusma@yahoo.com Here is the most up-to-date information:

- Based on feedback from previous matches, the upcoming match will be a 2 Gun Rifle and Pistol Match. This is to make the match a little more oriented towards military like tactics.
- Fee will remain at \$125.00 per shooter with a match tee shirt included.
- Civilian shooters will only have 100 slots. The remaining 25 will be for ACTIVE Military. Application cutoff dates will be listed for both. If the match sells out, a waiting list will be created. Details will be part of the match application.
- We are currently looking at 8 stages of fire. We may be rolling out some exciting "toys," but you will have to show-up to see them.
- The food concession has gone through a major overhaul. The Combats Weapons Team has decided to allow one of the other West Point clubs to run two food concession stands. This will eliminate some of the previous complications and allow us to increase the CWT range staff.
- There will be a rifle caliber restriction in place. Details will be on the application.
- There will be two classes: tactical and open. Details will follow.
- This is a trophy only match. Award breakdown will be posted on the web site. We are planning on a door prize table.
