Dear Retiree and Family Members:

You and your family are cordially invited to the Thirty Second Annual Retiree Open House at West Point on April 22, 2006. On this day, the United States Military Academy will honor you and your family members for your dedicated service to our country.

All cars with DoD decals can enter through any gate. If you do not have a DoD decal, you must enter through Thayer or Stony Lonesome Gate. To expedite the process, please have picture ID readily available to show to the Security Guards. Designated parking is available in the vicinity of Eisenhower Hall, North Dock, and west of Gillis Field House. Shuttle buses will be available from 0715 to 0930 to transport you to Eisenhower Hall. Limited parking will be available for handicapped vehicles in the Tunnel Area of Eisenhower Hall. There will be very limited parking in the central post area. To assist the Military Police, please display the special parking pass enclosed in your front windshield.

Upon arriving at Eisenhower Hall, take the elevator to the Ballroom Level. You must register yourself and your guests at the Reception desk. There will again be two separate registration areas. One will be for those with luncheon reservations and one for those without. Name tags will be issued to all participants. You can meet, in a "County Fair" setting, with post activities and civilian agencies that provide services to the retired community from 0745-1100. At 0830, the Superintendent will welcome all retirees and their guests in the theater. Immediately following his welcome, SGM (Ret) Leroy A. Bussells, Assistant Director Retiree Affairs, Association of the United States Army will speak on retiree issues and concerns. Following him will be Mr. John Benedict from Retired and Annuity Pay, Defense Finance and Accounting Service, Cleveland Center, who will present a briefing on pay matters. Between 1100-1120 retirees and their guests will proceed to the Reviewing Stands on The Plain for a Cadet Review. Everyone must be seated by 1120. Bus transportation will be provided from the first floor tunnel entrance of Eisenhower Hall for those who are unable to walk to The Plain.

At 1120, ten minutes prior to the Review, the Cadet Drill Team will perform on the Plain. The Review will then begin at 1130, concluding with a Demonstration Jump by the Sports Parachute Team. **Promptly at 1230, the West Point Joint Retiree Council will host a luncheon in the Cadet Mess.** The luncheon is open to all Open House participants; however, reservations are required. Busing will be available at the conclusion of the program to return those not attending the luncheon to the designated parking areas. Pickup will be on Thayer Road Extension. Buses will also be available in the same location to take those unable to make the walk to the Mess Hall for the luncheon. Immediately following the luncheon, shuttle buses will be available from the Mess Hall to the designated parking areas. Small buses will be available in the courtyard and larger buses will be staged near MacArthur Statue on Jefferson Road.

For your convenience, Vehicle Registration and ID Cards will be issued from 1130 – 1500 in Griffin Hall, Building 622. Call the number listed below with any questions.

SURVIVOR BENEFIT PLAN OPEN ENROLLMENT UNTIL 30 SEP 2006

The National Defense Authorization Act FY 2005 authorized an Open Enrollment period for the Survivor Benefit Plan. Retirees have the opportunity to participate in the Survivor Benefit Plan if they have not previously enrolled in SBP, made a less than full coverage option or have child only coverage. They will have the opportunity to enroll or increase their coverage during this Open Season. Retirees who want to elect or increase SBP coverage will have to make a lump sum payment covering all back premiums since retirement, plus interest. Enrollment forms have been provided in the Army Echoes. For counseling, cost estimates and assistance contact your Retirement Services Office at 845-938-4217.

CASUALTY ASSISTANCE FOR FAMILY MEMBERS

Casualty Assistance is provided by West Point for families of Army retirees who reside in the New York counties of Orange, Rockland, Sullivan, Dutchess, Columbia, Ulster, Greene, Delaware, Putnam, northern Westchester and the New Jersey counties of Sussex, Passaic and Bergen. The phone number is 845-938-4217.

The Casualty Assistance Office in Fort Drum, NY services residents of the other New York counties and the states of Massachusetts, Connecticut, Rhode Island, Maine, Vermont and New Hampshire. The phone number is 1-888-325-1601 or 315-772-6465. Immediate notification of a retiree death will enable the Casualty Assistance Office to notify the Defense Finance and Accounting Service in a timely manner to stop the retired pay. The sooner this is done the sooner benefits can be received by the surviving spouse. Check lists are published periodically in the Army Echoes. Be sure to update your checklist and be sure your family knows where it is located.
