

BATTLE OF FAIR OAKS, 31 MAY 1862

Lee assumed command on 1 June 1862.


The Seven days (25 June - 1 July) Battles included fighting at Mechanicsville, Gaine's Mill, Savage's Station, Frayser's farm, and Malvern Hill, as McClellan withdrew toward Harrison's Landing shifting his base from White House, which Lee attack constantly.

Movement from Yorktown area to Richmond, 5-24 May.

McClellan's forces were held up by Yorktown defenses, 5 April to 4 May 1862.

Jackson's force consisted of three divisions: Whiting's, Ewell's and Jackson's own.
