



**SAINT LAWRENCE RIVER
AND VICINITY, 1759**
THE AMERICAN COLONIAL WARS
Operations in Canada, 1759 - 1760



After the fall of Quebec, Vaudreuil withdrew to here and then to Montreal, leaving small detachments along the river during the winter of 1759-60.

Lévis retreated May 1760. Most of his Canadian militia and Indians deserted.

Murray (2,450) advance from Quebec, July 1760

Wolfe, June 1759

Lévis (8,500) advanced on Quebec, April 1760.

Amherst (10,000) advanced from Oswego, August 1760.

Haviland (3,400) advanced from Crown Point, August 1760.

French position outflanked and abandoned, 27 August 1760. Garrison retired through Sorel to Montreal.
