

A meeting engagement. Cornwallis attacked with his right flank, stampeding the American militia and calvary. The Continentals in reserve advanced to restore the line but were outflanked and defeated. Meanwhile the American right drove back the British left until overwhelmed in flank and rear by the converging British infantry and calvary. Few escaped.
