



Britain maintained a military force of just under 170,000 men in the home islands. 90,000 of these were regulars and 77,000 were militia.

Prussian forces demobilized in March began mobilizing again in August.

No attempt has been made to depict the boundaries of minor states, principalities, and duchies in Germany and Italy. For simplicity, the identifications of many of these territories have been purposely omitted.

Austria remained neutral during the campaigns of 1806 and 1807.

Russia and the Ottoman Empire kept up a desultory war along the Bessarabian territory from 1806 to 1812.

The Confederation of the Rhine originally included the following states: Bavaria, Württemberg, Baden, Berg, Hesse-Darmstadt, Nassau, and nine smaller principalities and Duchies; Würzburg, Saxony and the Saxon Duchies joined the Confederation after the battle of Jena. The Kingdom of Westphalia declared itself a member in 1807.
