


Only those secondary roads in the vicinity of Waterloo-Charleroi appear on this map. Also, only the forest south of Brussels is depicted because of its tactical significance. All other forests are omitted for purposes of clarity.

The advance of Schwarzenberg and Kleist had not yet begun. These formations were still awaiting the arrival of the Russian army on the Rhine.

Mobilization of French forces continued during the campaign.
