### PRINCETON REVIEW RANKS U.S. MILITARY ACADEMY AMONG BEST COLLEGES

West Point also is on the following ranking lists in “The Best 382 Colleges:” No. 2 for Most Accessible Professors, No. 2 for Lots of Race/Class Interaction, No. 4 for Best Health Services, No. 4 for Everyone Plays Intramural Sports, and No. 5 in Best College Library.
