

GRADUATION WEEK SHUTTLE BUS INFORMATION

Wednesday, May 24–Friday, May 26 – Shuttle buses will circulate around West Point, 8 a.m.-11 p.m.

The recommended parking areas are “A” Lot, additional surrounding lettered lots and Buffalo Soldier Field.

**These buses will be equipped with GPS trackers – this is only for the Graduation Augmentation shuttles, not graduation day or handicapped buses. Or, you can download the RideSystems App from Google Play or the iPhone App Store.

Select “West Point” and track the bus!

The buses will be marked with **GRADUATION POST SHUTTLE** or **GRADUATION AUGMENTATION SHUTTLE** and will stop at the following locations – **stops will be indicated on the map**:

“A” LOT – *parking is available in the lettered lots near Michie Stadium, Wednesday, May 24-Friday, May 26*

“K Lot – located north of the West Point Cemetery, near Subway and Starbucks

NORTH DOCK (Stop is at the base of the hill – at river level)

IKE HALL (Tunnel area – near Box Office Doors)

THAYER STATUE/Ruger Road

SUPT’S REVIEW BOX (Clinton parking lot)

WEST POINT CLUB/LIBRARY CORNER

MAHAN HALL (Stops in the tunnel)

THAYER EXTENTION (Bus shelter at the entrance to Grant Turnaround area)

BUFFALO SOLDIER FIELD – parking is available at this location - (Bus shelter)

VISITORS CENTER (service to the Visitors Center ends at 6 p.m.)

HOTEL THAYER (Stop is on Thayer Road)

HERBERT ALUMNI CENTER (Located on Mills Road)

HOLLEDER CENTER (located on the west side of Michie Stadium)

“A” LOT (parking area)



Buses for the Superintendent’s Receptions on Wednesday, May 24 and Thursday, May 25 will run directly to Quarters 100 (or Ike Hall if impacted by weather) from the parking lots near Michie Stadium.

Buses for Constitution Island run from the Superintendent’s Review Box in Clinton Lot to South Dock between 12:30 & 5 p.m. on Wednesday, May 24 & Thursday, May 25.

Information from the Graduation FAQ - **Constitution Island – Boat ride and tour** – guests will have an opportunity to take a boat ride from South Dock to Constitution Island, located just to the east of West Point in the Hudson River. Guests will step off the boat at the Constitution Island dock where they will be greeted by a guide who will share the history of the island. Travel time to the island is approximately 15 minutes. The crew will share information on the history and geography of the river while in transit. There are 7 tours planned. The first tour will depart at 12:45 p.m. Tours will continue every 30 minutes with the last tour departing (South Dock) at 3:45 p.m. returning by 5 p.m. Tours (including boat ride) will last approximately 90 minutes. Please use the shuttle service from Clinton parking lot (near the Supt’s Review Box) to South Dock. Parking at South Dock is very limited. These tours are free – no cost to participants. Tour capacity is 36 passengers. Reservations NOT accepted. First come, first served.

All passengers must disembark upon arrival at Constitution Island.

Saturday, May 27, Graduation Day Bus Information

Buses will start running at 6 a.m.

WHEEL CHAIR - Handicapped Shuttle – Please park in Clinton Lot (near the Plain, Daly Field area). Buses will pick up near Johnson Stadium (please wait on the sidewalk near the glass doors). Buses for guests not requiring handicapped accommodations will also be available. Buses will return guests to the same location following the ceremony.

Guests (in wheel chairs) will be dropped off at the entrance to the Kimsey Center for handicapped accessible seating. Following the graduation ceremony shuttle buses will be available to transport guests to Central Post Area (Clinton Lot) for commissioning (bar pinning) ceremonies. Buses will run continuously from the Superintendent's Review Box to the various parking lots until 6 p.m.

Red Route: (PX/Commissary), Drop-off at A-Lot with access through Gates 5/6. Following the ceremony, guests will be transported to the PX/Commissary area.

Green Route: (South end of West Point) - Buffalo Soldier Field (Post Office), South Dock, Drop-off near Herbert Alumni Center. If your guests are mobile, but have challenges walking distances, golf carts will be available to assist as needed. Buses will return to Buffalo Soldier Field and South Dock following the ceremony.

Blue Route: (North end of West Point) - Prior to the ceremony - North Dock (RV Parking), Thayer Statue, Clinton Lot & Daly Field area (Handicap Parking area), Washington Rd, K-Lot (near Subway/Starbucks) then on to A-Lot for drop off.

Following the ceremony, **Blue Route Buses** will pick up at "A" Lot, traveling to Clinton Lot/Daly Field (Handicapped parking area), Washington Road, K-Lot (near Subway/Starbucks) and North Dock.

Additional information:

Restrooms – *Restrooms are indicated on the map, but can be found near the entrance to the West Point Cemetery, below Trophy Point near the First Class Club, Johnson Stadium (baseball field), Cadet Chapel and Visitors Center. Additionally portable comfort stations are available at Daly Field.*

Medical Aid – A first-aid tent will be set up behind the reviewing stands on Friday, May 26 and they will have roving medics on duty. Additionally, roving teams of medics will be present at the stadium for the graduation ceremony, Saturday, May 27.

Side Note: On graduation day, please keep in mind the bus routes work well if you think through your timeline and plan for the day; graduation ceremony, bar pinning location, luncheon/family gathering and end of the day departure. **Unless you or your guests require handicapped accommodations, please do not park in Clinton Lot.**
