

Driving Directions to West Point

- **You are required to have a photo ID to enter the gates as a driver or passenger**
- **FROM NEW YORK CITY**
 - Head north to the George Washington Bridge/I-95 South. Cross the bridge via the **upper** deck, and stay in the right lane.
 - Exit immediately at the end of the bridge to Palisades Interstate Parkway
 - Take Palisades Interstate Parkway north 37 miles until it ends at the Bear Mountain Bridge traffic circle. Proceed $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way around the circle, following signs for West Point and Route 9W North. Stay on Route 9W for 4.4 miles
 - Take the **RT-218 S** ramp toward **Stony Lonesome Gate**
 - Enter Stony Lonesome Gate and follow the signs to “A lot” about a mile and a half down Stony Lonesome road on the left. If you pass the football stadium you have gone too far.
- **FROM SOUTH/NEW JERSEY**
 - Travel north on the NJ Turnpike/I-95 to exit 73 toward RT-67/Fort Lee – just before the George Washington Bridge. Stay left and take your first left at Lemoine Ave. Continue straight for $\frac{1}{2}$ mile then bear right onto the Palisades Interstate Pkwy North. SEE DIRECTIONS FROM PALISADES INTERSTATE PARKWAY ABOVE.
- **FROM THE WEST**
 - Travel east on Interstate 80 through New Jersey and take exit 43 to merge onto Interstate 287 northbound toward Mahwah. After entering New York, take the exit onto the New York State Thruway South toward the Tappan Zee Bridge. Take exit 13N for the Palisades Parkway North toward Bear Mountain. SEE DIRECTIONS FROM PALISADES INTERSTATE PARKWAY ABOVE
- **FROM THE NORTH/NEW ENGLAND**
 - Travel west on Interstate 84 until you cross the Newburgh-Beacon Bridge. Follow signs for Route 9W South (exit 10S). Stay on Route 9W for approximately 12 miles until you cross over a large mountain. As you are in your final descent off the mountain, you will encounter three exits on your right for West Point
 - Take the second exit (labeled “West Point/Highland Falls/Rte. 218”) to Stony Lonesome gate. SEE DIRECTIONS FROM STONY LONESOME GATE ABOVE.

Railroad to West Point

- Metro-North has rail service from Grand Central Station to **Garrison Station**, directly across from West Point, daily. There will be a shuttle service to provide transportation to West Point from Garrison Station. BE SURE TO SPECIFY TIME OF ARRIVAL ONLINE.

Bus to West Point

- Short Line Bus offers daily bus service from the New York City Port Authority, near Times Square in Manhattan, to the West Point Visitors center, as do many other bus services. If arriving by bus, be sure to arrive at the **West Point Visitors Center bus stop**. A shuttle service will transport you inside the gates and to registration. BE SURE TO SPECIFY TIME OF ARRIVAL ONLINE.
