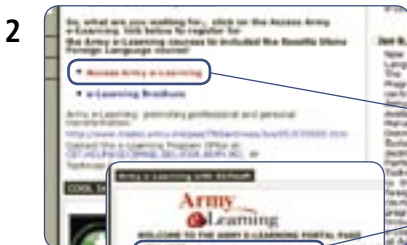

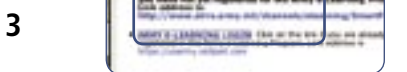

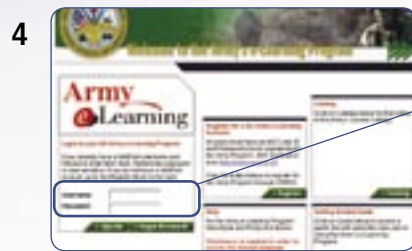
1 Login to AKO, then click on **My Education**.



2 Click on **Access Army e-Learning**.



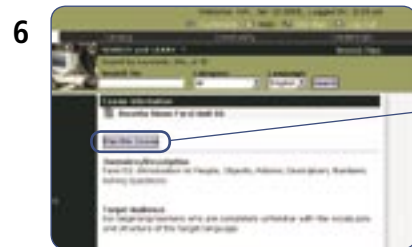
3 Click on **Army e-Learning Login** or **Register for Army e-Learning** if you are a new user.



4 Login with your Army e-Learning Username and Password.



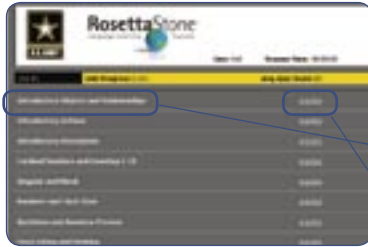
5 Click on **Rosetta Stone Foreign Language Courses** and select the language you wish to study, then choose **Unit 01**.

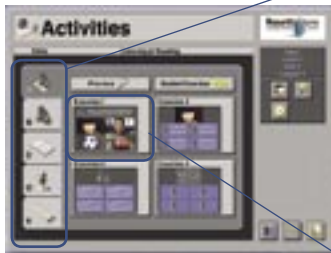
